SUPPLY TENDER**

<p>Supply Contract Notice Point 16: Selection criteria, sub-point 3 It is mentioned that "the tenderer should have at least 1 contract with a budget equal to or exceeding the financial proposal of the tenderer in similar fields (supply/sale of pedigree cattle) during the last three years counted from the tender submission deadline." Please kindly specify the list of mandatory documents which should be provided by the tenderer acting in the form of consortium/ joint venture as a prove of successful completion or implementation of the part of the similar contract; and Is it considered appropriate for Contracting Authority if in the case of the tenderer is a consortium one member covers the above mentioned criteria?</p>	<p>According to Article 21 Signature of the contract and performance guarantee of the Instructions to tenderers, which says</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The successful tenderer must also provide evidence of financial and economic standing and technical and professional capacity according to the selection criteria for this call for tenders specified in the contract notice, point 16 if required by the Contracting Authority. The documentary proofs required are listed in section 2.4.11 of the Practical Guide. <p>at this period, the provision of documentary proofs regarding the evidence of financial and economic standing as well as technical and professional capacity according to the selection criteria is not mandatory, it will be asked after the evaluation session from the successful tenderer before awarding the contract.</p> <p>According to Article 2.4.11.1.3. Verifying the technical and professional capacity of candidates or tenderers of PRAG 2015.0 "Evidence of successful implementation must take the form of certificates issued or countersigned by the contracting authority or entity who ordered or purchased the execution of the service or supply". In order for your consortium to comply with the technical selection criteria, at least <i>one</i> of the members/partners of the consortium must satisfy that criterion.</p>
<p>An economic operator may, where appropriate and for a particular contract, rely on the capacities of other entities, regardless of the legal nature of the links which it has with them. Some examples of when it may not be considered appropriate by the Contracting Authority are when the tenderer rely in majority on the capacities of other entities or when they rely on key criteria. If the tenderer rely on other entities it must prove to the Contracting Authority that it will have at its disposal the resources necessary for performance of the contract, for example by producing an undertaking on the part of those entities to place those resources at its disposal. Such entities, for instance the parent company of the economic operator, must respect the same rules of</p>	<p>In procurement procedures for service and supply contracts, the selection criteria are applied to the consortium as a whole, meanwhile the eligibility rules apply to all the members of the consortium.</p> <p>According to Procurement and Grants for European Union external actions - A Practical Guide Applicable as of 15 July 2015 term "economic operator" covers contractors, suppliers and service providers.</p>
